


FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Some things you're probably wondering!

Are there car parking facilities close to the venue?

Yes, the Albert Heijn supermarket located on the Hooigracht has car parking facilities at the rear of the supermarket on the Middelstegracht.

Buurtcentrum De Pancrat Middelstegracht 85, 2312TT (See A on map) - the venue for the Home in Leiden Clothes swop is 1 minute walking distance from the Albert Heijn.



Is there an entrance cost?

We kindly ask each person joining in the clothes swop to contribute 1 euro. This covers the cost of renting the room for the evening and also allows us to buy some nibbles.

Is any money exchanged for the clothes at the clothes swop?

NO, nada, geen cent ... This is what is so exciting about a clothes swop. You get lots of stuff for FREE!

What type of clothes are desired ?

We would love to get a variety of clothes (styles and sizes for men and women), shoes, costume jewelry (no studded earrings) and accessories suitable for the current season, i.e. autumn / winter. We plan to hold a spring/ summer swishing party in 2013, so hold off on the sandals and sarongs for the moment!

Are men's clothes also available to swish?

Considering that most women tend to sort out their other halves' wardrobe anyway, we also encourage you to bring men's clothes. So yes, there will be a section, although considerably smaller than the ladies section. You never know what little gem you might discover for your loved one!

What happens if two ladies crave the same item?
